

Tutorial No. 7 – Installing RazorLame

The zip file 'RAIBCRazorLame.zip' is a special file which you can either get by sending me an E-Mail or download from the Web-site.

RAIBCRazorLame has been specially configured to run correctly when installed in the 'RazorLame' folder on drive 'C' and automatically looks for wave files in the WAVE folder and stores the MP3 files in the MP3 folder on drive 'C'.

- 1) Go to the web page and download the zip file
- 2) Use Winzip, 7zip or any other program to unzip the RazorLame files into the folder RazorLame on drive 'C'
- 3) If you use Winzip then start WINZIP
- 4) Move the cursor to the OPEN icon at the top right of the screen and LEFT click on it
- 5) Left click on the down arrow and find Drive 'C' and left click on it
- 6) Find the folder 'RazorLame' and LEFT click on it
- 7) LEFT click on the file 'RAIBCRazorLame.zip' and then LEFT click on the OPEN button

A list of all the files in RAIBCRazorLame.zip is displaced on the screen

- 8) Move the cursor to the EXTRACT icon and LEFT click on it
- 9) Make sure there is a green spot next to ALL FILES/FILDERS IN ARCHIVE
- 10) Make sure there is a tick next to OVERWRITE EXISTING FILES
- 11) Make sure there is a tick next to USE FOLDER NAMES
- 12) LEFT click on the EXTRACT button

All of the files have now been extracted and saved in the folder 'RAZORLAME' on drive 'C'

- 13) Close WINZIP
- 14) Move cursor to bottom left of screen to the START button and RIGHT click on it
- 15) Move up to EXPLORERE and LEFT click on it
- 16) Find Drive 'C' and LEFT click on it
- 17) On the right hand side of the screen find the folder 'RAZORLAME' and double click on it

The RazorLame folder opens and you see all of the files

Now you want to create a shortcut to Razorlame and put it on the desktop

- 18) Move cursor to the top right of the screen and find the icon which loops like two overlapping boxes and LEFT click on it

The EXPLORER window is now made smaller and you can see the DESKTOP

- 19) Find the file 'razorlame.exe' which is marked by a sword
- 20) RIGHT click on the file and holding the button depressed drag the file to a spare space on the desktop and release the button
- 21) In the new list DO NOT USE COPY OR MOVE but go down to CREATE SHORTCUT and LEFT click on it

You will now see a shortcut to Razorlame on the desktop which you can use in Tutorial 8 to start RazorLame
